Looking after your car's paintwork...

When starting anything, it's often hard to know where to start, never mind looking after your car's paintwork properly. Doing it well can be a bit of a maze, there are several different levels, with quite a few different techniques and theories, but we're here to start you off on some of the basics. Basics that probably sound too detailed to be basic, but we can assure you this is as *basic* as proper maintenance gets....

Washing the car Step 1

Always, always, always start with the wheels. We can't say it enough. Your wheels are the grubbier area of the car so will require a good pre-soak with a quality wheel cleaner. You'll need a good brush to get to the hard-to-reach areas, along with a separate wash mitt and bucket than you'd use on the paintwork. Or just make sure you clean your wash mitt and bucket thoroughly before you start on the car body
